

CONDITIONS

about the qualifying tournament for the Seventh World Championship in international draughts on the website E-Dama Semifinal. Tournament Code: P/ChMM - 7S

1. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES

The objectives of the competition are: the further development and popularization of draughts game, the enhancement of sportsmanship, the identification of the strongest draughts players, the preservation and expansion of contacts between the draughts players.

2. MANAGEMENT OF THE TOURNAMENT

The tournament is conducted by the head of section "100" of SLSHI

3. PROCEDURE FOR THE TOURNAMENT

The competition is held without tournament fee in accordance with this Regulation and the approved Tournament Regulations.

The tournament is held on the server site: <http://e-dama.net>

The tournament starts on 13 March 2019.

The end of the tournament - on completion of all games.

Participants play with each other for one game.

4. COMPOSITION OF TOURNAMENT PARTICIPANTS

The quantitative composition of the semifinal: 16-30 players.

Registration on the website E-Dama

If there are more than 22 applications, participants will be divided into 2 subgroups "A" and "B"

5. DEFINITION OF WINNERS. EXIT

For the victory in each game, the player receives 3 points,

for a draw - 1 point,

for a draw with material advantage - 2 points

for the defeat - 0 points.

If at the end of game with a theoretically tied result, one of side will have a material advantage of 2 units, then the points are distributed according to the judge's decision in the ratio 2:1.

The places of the competitors are determined by the amount of points collected. The winner is the player who scored the most points. The distribution of places for players with equal points is made according to the following criteria: 1) Shmul'yan-Dvorkovich coefficient; 2) the results of personal meetings; 3) the greatest number of victories.

Participants of the tournament who took 1-3 places in each of the subgroups are allowed on the final of World Championship t. ChMM-7S.
